We will be covering most of chapters 1, 2, 3, and section 4.1.

Prerequisites: Satisfactory score on the ELM or passing grade in Math 120.

Homework: Homework problems from each section will be assigned during each class and will be collected at the beginning of class on Thursdays. In addition to the collected homework, suggested problems will also be given for extra practice. No late homework will be collected for any reason. Instead, your lowest two homework scores will be dropped. Your success in this class will depend on whether or not you take the time to do the homework problems. The problems on the exams will be similar to the homework. Therefore, it is strongly recommended that you do the problems as soon after we have covered the material in class. We can answer questions in class but may not have time to answer every question. Please come see me during my office hours if you need extra help. You may also work with another student on homework, but make sure that the work you submit is your own.

Exams: There will be two midterms in weeks 4 and 8 (see schedule below for dates). The final exam will be cumulative. No makeup exams will be given unless you have a verifiable excuse. Your final exam score may replace your lowest midterm score. Calculator use on exams will be limited.

Attendance: Attendance is very important for your success in this class. I will take attendance during each class by passing around a sign-in sheet 5 minutes after the start of class. If you have not signed in by this time, you will not get credit for attendance that day. I may use your attendance and participation to determine borderline grades. If you miss two class meetings during the first two weeks, you may be dropped to make room for students trying to add the course.

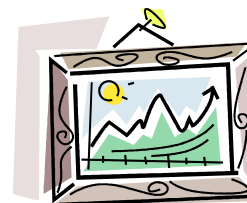
